

### **Apprenticeship Data Publication 2022 to 2023**

All public bodies with 250 or more staff in England are in scope of 'The Public Sector Apprenticeship Target Regulations 2017' and are thereby required to produce apprentice data information.

Academy Trusts came within scope of these regulations with effect from 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 and so the first annual return was for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019. This is the fifth annual return and covers the period from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023.
